1 RULES

- 1.1* The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) incl. Appendix E*.
- 1.2* The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' will apply. The Equipment Rules of Sailing, the IRSA Championship Regulations, the Heat Management System, the IRSA Addendum Q 2013 and the IRSA System for Reduced Protest Hearings (SYRPH) version 2013 will apply.
- 1.3 Racing rule(s) 62.2, 64.1, 65.2, 66, E6.5 will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules as well.
- 1.4 n/a
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.6* Every competitor who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats will not be required to display advertising chosen by the organising authority

3* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the IOM class.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 If (a) boat(s) break(s) a rule of the RRS and no boat takes a one turn penalty immediately the protest committee is entitled to penalize a boat by instructing her to take a two turns penalty including two tacks and two gybes. This changes E7(b)

11.2 Decisions of jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5. The Royal Netherlands Yachting Union has granted permission under RRS 70.5(a)

12 SCORING

12.1* Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.



- 12.2** The heat management system (HMS) shall apply unless the number of participants is less than 17. A copy will be available at the race office.
- 12.3** RRS 64.2 is changed by HMS 2013 so that redress can be given by assigning a place with appropriate points.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be grey.

19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 , Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

20 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

21 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.

Protocol DIOMCA activiteiten 2020- NL

Algemeen protocol van DIOMCA om op een verantwoorde manier IOM RC zeilen in Nederland weer mogelijk te maken. Naast 1.5 meter maatregel zal alles gebaseerd zijn op de geldende adviezen van het RIVM.

Preambule:

- Deze afspraken gelden voor RC zeilwedstrijden met een IOM modelzeilboot waarbij er geen sprake is van fysiek contact tussen de sporters, en/of wedstrijdleiding.
- Uitgangspunt is dat de voorwaarden en maatregelen waarop de RC zeilwedstrijden kunnen worden bedreven helder en hanteerbaar moeten zijn voor alle zeilers en wedstrijdleiding.
- Zeilers, wedstrijdleiding en toeschouwers houden zich aan de RIVM-richtlijnen.

Algemene regels voor IOM zeilers:

- Houd 1,5 meter afstand.
- Kom het liefst alleen naar de wedstrijden.
- Reis alleen of reis alleen met personen uit jouw huishouden.
- Kom op eigen gelegenheid naar de wedstrijden.
- Tuig je boot op met meer dan 1,5 mtr afstand van elkaar.
- Blijf thuis als je een van de volgende klachten hebt of hebt gehad in de afgelopen 48 uur: neusverkoudheid, loopneus, niezen, keelpijn, lichte hoest, verhoging (vanaf 38 C°).
- Blijf thuis als iemand in jouw huis koorts heeft (vanaf de 38 C°) en/of benauwdheidsklachten.
- Schud geen handen.
- Was gedurende de dag vaak je handen.
- Desinfecteer je handen na het wassen.
- Volg altijd de aanwijzingen op van de wedstrijdleader.
- Ga voorafgaand aan de wedstrijden thuis naar het toilet. Op locaties waar we zeilen met faciliteiten, zal dit worden aangegeven.
- Betaal kosten voor inschrijvingen vooraf met internetbankieren
- Verlaat direct na de wedstrijden het gebied.

Regels tijdens de wedstrijden:

- Houd 1,5 mtr afstand.
- Bij de start procedure dient een mondkapje te worden gedragen
- In en uit het water halen, wachten op elkaar en houd 1,5 mtr afstand
- Niet schreeuwen.
- De wedstrijdleiding zal, daar waar nodig, looproutes maken daar waar dit niet kan, houd 1,5 mtr afstand.



Protokoll DIOMCA-Aktivitäten 2020-GER

Allgemeines Protokoll von DIOMCA, um IOM RC-Segeln in den Niederlanden auf verantwortungsvolle Weise zu ermöglichen. Zusätzlich zur 1,5-Meter-Entfernungsregel basiert alles auf den aktuellen Empfehlungen von RIVM.

Präambel:

- Diese Regeln gelten für RC-Segelwettbewerbe mit einem IOM-Segelboot, bei denen kein physischer Kontakt zwischen den Seglern und / oder dem Wettfahrtleitung besteht.
- Das Grundprinzip ist, dass die Bedingungen und Regeln, unter denen die RC-Segelwettbewerbe durchgeführt werden können, für alle Segler und Regattabeamten klar und überschaubar sein müssen.
- Segler, Wettfahrtleitung und Zuschauer halten sich an die RIVM-Richtlinien.

Allgemeine Regeln für IOM-Segler:

- Halten Sie 1,5 Meter Abstand
- Nehmen Sie am besten alleine an den Wettfahrten teil.
- Reisen Sie alleine oder nur mit Personen aus Ihrem Haushalt.
- Kommen Sie mit Ihrem eigenen Transportmittel zu den Regatten.
- Rüsten Sie Ihr Boot mit mindestens 1,5 Meter Abstand voneinander entfernt auf.
- Bleiben Sie zu Hause, wenn Sie in den letzten 48 Stunden eine der folgenden Beschwerden haben oder hatten: Erkältungen, laufende Nase, Niesen, Halsschmerzen, leichter Husten, Temperaturanstieg (ab 38 ° C).
- Bleiben Sie zu Hause, wenn jemand in Ihrem Haus Fieber (ab 38 ° C) und / oder Atemnot hat.
- Hände nicht schütteln.
- Waschen Sie Ihre Hände tagsüber oft.
- Desinfizieren Sie Ihre Hände nach dem Waschen.
- Befolgen Sie immer die Anweisungen der Wettfahrtleitung.
- Gehen Sie vor den Regatten zu Hause auf die Toilette. Der Weg zu den Toiletten wird an den Orten angegeben, an denen wir mit Sanitäreinrichtungen segeln.
- Bezahlen Sie die Teilnahmegebühren für Anmeldungen im Voraus bargeldlos mit z. B. Internetbanking
- Verlassen Sie den Bereich sofort nach den Regatten.

Regeln während der Regatten:

- Halten Sie 1,5 Meter Abstand zu anderen Personen.
- Während des Startvorgangs muss eine Mundmaske getragen werden
- Boote im und aus dem Wasser, warten aufeinander und halten 1,5 m Abstand



- Schreien Sie nicht.
- Die Wettfahrtleitung wird, falls erforderlich, Wege festlegen in den Bereichen wo es nicht möglich ist, 1,5 Meter Abstand zu anderen Personen zu halten.



Protocol DIOMCA activities 2020 -GBR

General protocol of DIOMCA to enable in a responsible way IOM RC sailing in the Netherlands. In addition to the 1.5 meter distance rule, everything will be based on the current advice from RIVM.

Preamble:

- These rules apply to RC sailing competitions with an IOM model sailing boat where there is no physical contact between the sailors and / or regatta officer.
- The basic principle is that the conditions and rules under which the RC sailing competitions can be operated must be clear and manageable for all sailors and regatta officer.
- Sailors, regatta officers and spectators adhere to the RIVM guidelines.

General rules for IOM sailors:

- Keep 1.5 meters distance.
- Preferably attend the games alone.
- Travel alone or travel only with people from your household.
- Come to the regattas using your own transportation.
- Rigging your boat more than 1.5 meters distance from each other.
- Stay at home if you have or have had any of the following complaints in the past 48 hours: colds, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, mild cough, increase (from 38 ° C).
- Stay at home if someone in your house has a fever (from 38 ° C) and / or shortness of breath.
- Do not shake hands.
- Wash your hands often during the day.
- Disinfect your hands after washing.
- Always follow the instructions of the regatta officer.
- Go to the toilet at home before the regattas. Routing to toilets will be indicated at locations where we sail with facilities.
- Pay entry-fees for registrations in advance with internet banking
- Leave the area immediately after the regattas.

Rules during regattas:

- Keep 1.5 meters distance.
- A mouth mask must be worn during the starting procedure .
- Boats in and out of the water, wait for each-other and keep 1.5 mtr distance
- Do not shout.
- The regatta officer will, if necessary, make walking routes, where this is not possible, keep 1.5 meters distance.
